

2013 MYSTERY QUILT

LARGE SIZE 78 1/2" X 98 1/2" WITH BORDERS

PART 1 OF 4

Note: When selecting fabric colors, make sure you have a strong contrast between all fabrics. Use your color wheel when making selections. Value is key. This quilt would be very pretty with same color as long as there is a distinct difference in the fabric values selected.

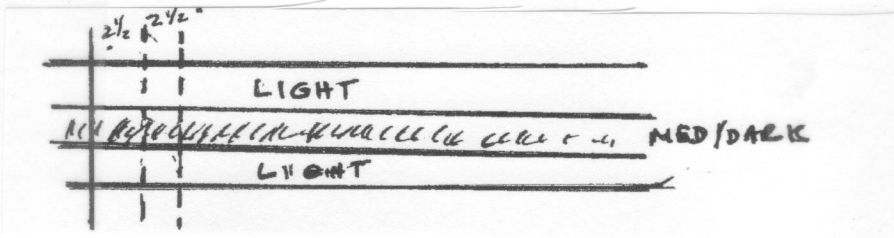
VALUES	FABRIC REQUIRED WITH BORDERS AND BINDING
LIGHT BACKGROUND	3 3/4 YARDS
MEDIUM	1 3/4 YARD
MED/DARK	2 1/2 YARDS
DARK	2 3/4 YARDS

BLOCK 1:

Using your light and med/dark fabric, cut:

(16) 2 1/2" light strips

(8) 2 1/2" med/dark strips



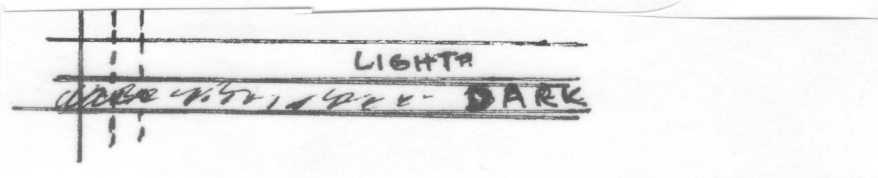
1. Sew a light strip lengthwise to each side of med/dark strip. Press seam allowance to light fabric

2. Square up one end of strip set and cut as many 2 1/2" segments as possible. A total **(124) 2 1/2" segments are needed for future steps.**

Using your light and dark fabric, cut

(9) 1 1/2" light strips

(9) 1 1/2" dark strips



1. Sew a light strip lengthwise to a dark strip. Press seam allowance toward dark strip.

2. Square up end of strip and cut as many 1 1/2" segments as possible. (248) 1 1/2' segments are needed

3. Sew together and make **(124) Four-Patch units.**



PLEASE PUT ALL PIECES IN A PLASTIC BAG AND MARK "BLOCK 1". WE ARE USING THE SAME FABRIC FOR BLOCK 2 SO IT CAN GET CONFUSING
