

Chart for Flying Geese

Finished Size	Cutting "Sky" Fabric	Cutting "Geese"
1 1/2" x 3"	Cut (4) 2 3/8" squares	Cut (1) 4 1/4" square
2" x 4"	Cut (4) 2 7/8" squares	Cut (1) 5 1/4" square
2 1/2" x 5"	Cut (4) 3 3/8" squares	Cut (1) 6 1/4" square
3" x 6"	Cut (4) 3 7/8" squares	Cut (1) 7 1/4" square

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the "Sky" fabric squares. Divide the Sky Fabric squares into two equal stacks. One stack will be used first and the other stack will be set aside till later.
2. Place two "Sky" fabric squares on the "Geese" fabric square, right sides together on opposite corners. Make sure that the corners overlap in the center and the diagonal line runs straight across the Geese fabric. Sew a 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line.
3. Cut the "Geese" square in half on the diagonal drawn line.
4. Fold back and "finger press" the two "Sky" squares to form a "heart" shape. Repeat this step one more time with the other half of the "Geese" fabric.
5. Place the third "Sky" fabric square in the empty corner of the "Geese" fabric and sew a 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line. Repeat this step with the fourth "Sky" fabric placed on the other "heart" shape.
6. Cut the Geese Blocks apart on the drawn lines. Press away from the "Geese" fabric. Repeat as you make as many "Flying Geese" as needed.
